Q: Understanding the relationship between page and framework in ASP.NET I'm building a new ASP.NET app for school, and I'm getting a little confused about the relationship between the page and the framework. The crux of the issue comes down to this: Say I create a new project using the "ASP.NET Web Application (.NET Framework)", what does this mean? Is this actually a framework (the name doesn't suggest it at all) or is it a project template (akin to Visual Studio)? My confusion arises because the Microsoft documentation on ASP.NET says that you "must use the .NET Framework to develop ASP.NET applications." If it's a framework, then why can I create a new project using the .NET Framework? If it's a template, then why does it say I must use .NET Framework in the documentation? Can someone explain the relationship between a framework and a template/project?

A: You can use the .NET Framework for your ASP.NET projects, but you need to do some configuration to make it work.

Q: Not understanding the solution to the one-dimensional Heat Equation I'm having trouble understanding what's going on in the solution to this problem. It's really not clear to me how the solution is arrived at; I don't understand the step of $k=2$, $t=\frac{1}{2}$ and then the substitution $y=\frac{z}{t^2}$. A: We want to solve the equation $u_t - u_{xx} = 0$ with $u(x,0) = 0$. The ansatz for the solution is $u(x,t) = \sum_{k=-\infty}^{\infty} a_k e^{ikx - k^2 t}$, where the a_k are
