Despite Kerry's insistence that the attack had nothing to do with al-Qaeda, Cooper had a different take, speaking in an interview with a British newspaper, in which he suggested that the attacks might have been al-Qaeda-linked. As Cooper told it, the attack began when militants cut through a fence and entered the compound, and the warning lights on the facility's alarm system didn't go off because the guards at the facility didn't press the correct buttons. Cooper said he was in the facility with Kerry when the attack began, and that his superiors "were very aggressive in denying that the attack was, in fact, planned or organized by al-Qaeda." The Associated Press reported that Cooper was in a meeting when the attack began. A number of U.S. officials, including former U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations Susan Rice, have said that the attack was not a planned terrorist attack.
